Regulations:

1. Refer to Rules & Regulations at the front of this book for deadlines, times and procedures for entry, exhibit delivery and exhibit pick-up.
2. All work must be original, done only by the exhibitor in the last two years, and not have been entered in any previous Salmon Arm Fair.
3. All paintings must be framed, complete with wire for hanging, OR THEY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. Pictures that are improperly framed or wired will not be accepted due to the risk of harming other paintings and projects. Works on paper must be behind glass.
4. Maximum size for all media is 36" in any direction.
5. The convenors have the right to regroup classes if too few are entered in a class.
6. Adult Class is 18 years of age and over. Youth is 11 to 17. Child is 10 and under.
