Regulations:

- Refer to Rules & Regulations at the front of this book for deadlines, times and procedures for entry, exhibit delivery and exhibit pick-up.
- All work must be original, done only by the exhibitor in the last two years, and not have been entered in any previous Salmon Arm Fair.
- All paintings must be framed, complete with wire for hanging, OR THEY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. Pictures that are improperly framed or wired will not be accepted due to the risk of harming other paintings and projects. Works on paper must be behind glass.
- Maximum size for all media is 36" in any direction.
- The convenors have the right to regroup classes if too few are entered in a class.
- Adult Class is 18 years of age and over. Youth is 11 to 17. Child is 10 and under.
- "Any Age" class is new in 2018 and encourages families to create together!

1. Fairies and Fantasy 2D – any 2D work depicting fantasy creatures
2. Fairies and Fantasy 3D – any 3D work featuring fairies, fairy houses, fantasy subjects, dragons, etc.
3. Basketry – any material
4. Sculpture made from recycled items
5. Artist Trading Cards (3) - Submit three cards, must be original works of art (no stamping or photocopying) and 2 ½ x 3 ½ inches. A trade session will be held at 4:30pm on Sunday at the A1 display.

ADULT CLASSES: (18 & over) PAINTING AND DRAWING

All paintings and drawings must be framed, complete with wire for hanging, and must be an original composition, OR THEY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. Wrap-around canvas paintings can be unframed but must be wired.

6. Acrylic or Oil Painting: landscape
7. Acrylic or Oil Painting: portrait (people or animals)
8. Acrylic or Oil Painting: any subject
9. Watercolour Painting: landscape
10. Watercolour Painting: portrait (people or animals)
11. Watercolour Painting: any subject
12. Drawing: Black and White
13. Drawing: Colour (pastels, coloured pencils)
14. Mixed Media: 2D

ADULT CLASSES: (18 & over) POTTERY AND SCULPTURE

3D work must be stable and have all parts attached.

15. Pottery – sculpture – handbuilt
16. Pottery – functionware – handbuilt or wheelwork
17. Pottery – platter
18. Pottery – mug (with handle)
19. Sculpture – metal
20. Sculpture – any media not listed
21. Mixed Media 3D – furniture, glass, etc

ADULT CLASSES: (18 & over) OTHER MEDIA

22. Jewellery – any media – handmade and original
23. Tie-Dye/Batik/Fabric Painting – any article of clothing (t-shirts etc)
24. Handmade card – original painting or drawing (must be 4"x6")
25. Handmade card – mixed media / stamped / scrapbooking materials (4"x6")
26. Stained glass – any item

ADULT CLASSES: (18 & over) WOODWORKING

All items must be less than 30" in any direction. Exceptions must be approved by convenor in advance of delivery. Wall-mounted items must have secure hardware attached.

27. Functional object – furniture, toy, shelf, etc.
28. Marquetry, Inlay or Intarsia – any item
29. Bird/Bat/Bee House – natural materials only
30. Woodwork – any item not listed

YOUTH CLASSES – (11 to 17 years) PAINTING AND DRAWING

All paintings and drawings must be framed, complete with secure wire for hanging, and must be an original composition, OR THEY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. Wrap-around canvas can be unframed but must be wired.

31. Acrylic Painting: landscape (canvasses must have wire)
32. Acrylic Painting: people or animals (canvasses must have wire)
33. Acrylic Painting: any subject (canvasses must have wire)
34. Watercolour: any subject (must be framed behind glass, with wire)
35. Drawing: Black and White (must be framed behind glass, with wire)
36. Drawing: Colour (must be framed behind glass, with wire)
37. Mixed Media (must be framed behind glass, with wire)

YOUTH CLASSES – (11 to 17 years) POTTERY AND SCULPTURE

3D work must be stable and have all parts attached.

38. Pottery - any hand built piece of functionware
39. Pottery - any wheelwork
40. Sculpture – clay
41. Sculpture – mixed media

YOUTH CLASSES – (11 to 17 years) FABRIC, JEWELLERY AND OTHER MEDIA

42. Jewellery – any media – handmade and original
43. Tie-Dye/Batik/Fabric Painting – any article of clothing (t-shirt, etc.)
44. Paper Media – collage, papier mache
45. Handmade card – original painting or drawing (4" x 6")

YOUTH CLASSES – (11 to 17 years) WOODWORKING

All items must be less than 36" in any direction. Exceptions must be approved by convenor in advance of delivery. Wall-mounted items must have secure hardware attached.

46. Functional item – toy, small furniture, piggy bank, etc.
47. Handcarved item – any sculpture or functional item, carved with hand tools only
48. Bird/Bee/Bat House – natural materials only
49. Woodwork – any item not listed

CHILDREN'S CLASSES: (10 & under) PAINTING AND DRAWING

Division A1 – Arts & Crafts

All paintings and drawings must be framed, complete with wire for hanging, and must be an original composition. Parents: take care to frame your child's work properly with a secure wire. We want to be able to show ALL children's artwork.

50. Painting: Watercolour (must be framed behind glass, with wire)
51. Painting: Acrylic (canvas must have wire on back)
52. Drawing: Black and White (pencil, ink, must be framed behind glass, with wire)
53. Drawing: Colour (pastels, crayons, must be framed behind glass, with wire)
54. Collage and Mixed Media (two or more media combined, framed with wire)

CHILDREN'S CLASSES: (10 & under) POTTERY AND SCULPTURE

3D work must be stable and have all parts attached.

55. Pottery - any hand built clay sculpture
56. Paper mache – any item
57. Sculpture – any media not listed
58. Bird/Bee/Bat House: natural materials only
59. Woodwork: any item

CHILDREN'S CLASSES: (10 & under) FABRIC, JEWELLERY AND OTHER MEDIA

60. Jewellery – any article
61. Tie-Dye/Batik/Fabric Painting – any article of clothing (t-shirts, etc.)
62. Handmade card – any media (4"x6")
63. Collections: presented with all items labeled, 10 or more samples of a specific subject matter, ie. rocks, feathers, shells. Maximum size 24"x24"
64. Paper Pinwheel – A **BC Fairs category**
Maximum diameter 15cm (5"), using colour pencils, markers or crayons to decorate your pinwheel paper. You may also use stickers, buttons and ribbons. The completed pinwheel will be mounted on a plastic straw or wooden stick (max length 45cm or 1-8").
