- One entry only per exhibitor in each class, however an exhibitor may enter more than one class. **Also, please note: an entry can be registered into one class only, not into multiple classes**
- No exhibits accepted from out of province.
- No article previously shown at Salmon Arm Fair accepted.
- All work must be made by a non-professional entrant (exception in commercially quilted categories).
- Mount crochet and knit doilies, rigid mounts as indicated.
- Cup for "Highest Points in Fancy Work", can't be won by the same exhibitor for two years running.
- Work must be new (completed within 2 years).
- Soiled or worn articles disqualified.
- No antique dolls.
- Exhibits **MUST** be picked up at 5:00pm Sunday. If the exhibitor is unable to pick up his or her exhibit, he or she must make arrangements for someone else to do so. The Fair will **NOT** take responsibility for articles left after the Fair.

Optional: please bring items to help with the display of your entry ie. pictures of children wearing a garment, a teapot for a tea cozy etc.

NOTE: At the end of the Crochet, Knitting, Needlework, Sewing and Quilting Classes is a class for "Display Only". This class is for anything not listed but that an exhibitor would still like to display at the Fair. There will be a fifty cent entry fee for each item entered in these classes (for accountability) but they won't be judged and no prizes awarded. An Exhibitor may enter up to 2 items in each of these classes.
