- Entry should be displayed in an attractive way.

### **Class**

#### **Baled Hay Classes**

1. 1 bale of alfalfa hay
2. 1 bale of grass hay
3. 1 bale of mixed hay
4. 3 sheaves cultivated forage grasses – named  
Each sheaf to be at least 3" in diameter – tied
5. Silage – 1 full ziplock bag 10" x 10" approximately
6. 6 Corn stalks – tied in a bundle
7. 20 lbs. field potatoes
8. Large supersize pumpkin – must have weight attached

### **Prize money for the following classes:**

1<sup>st</sup> - \$6.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$4.00, 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$2.00

### **Class**

9. Salt block art – naturally licked by animals. Any size block. Attach a creative name.
10. Grain art – wheat weaving, wreathes, hanging arrangements etc.
11. Recycled art – horseshoes, twine, old boards etc.
