Regulations

3. The Salmon Arm Fair will let you know on Sunday, September 11th if the Salmon Arm Fair will be taking your entry to the BC Fairs Provincial Conference, October 20-22, 2016 at Sun Peaks. The selected entries will be entered in the Member's Choice category and if selected as overall winner, will be awarded a \$50.00 cash prize. Entries will be returned to the Salmon Arm Fair office and exhibitors will be contacted for return of items.

Class

1. **Hand Painted Garden Trowel** – Open to all ages.
Theme: BC Dogwood Flower
Maximum length 35cm.
Purchase a garden trowel, using any paint type decorate the metal surface of the trowel with the BC Dogwood Flower.
2. **Mini Scarecrow** – Ages 12 years & under.
Maximum Height 35cm.
Recycle household materials to create a mini scarecrow to stake or hang in your garden. Wire and/or string can be used to construct your project.
3. **Farming in BC** – Open to all ages.
Colour photography – Create a montage using 4 photos (each 5"x7") that illustrates the diverse range of products grown in BC. Each photo must be mounted on a 6'x8' black backing board and connected using either string, wire or ribbon to connect the montage for display. Photographs cannot be altered beyond standard optimization. Unmounted photographs will not be accepted.
