Regulations:

- Refer to Rules & Regulations at the front of this book for deadlines, times, and procedures for entry, exhibit delivery, and exhibit pick-up.
- On the back left hand corner include the name of the 4-H member, the 4-H club, and the class number of the exhibit. Do not put any information on the front of the photo.
- All photos must be mounted on or behind construction paper or mat. No heavy backings, frames, or glass will be accepted.
- Mat must not exceed more than 2" from the edge of the photo.
- All photos must be 5" x 7" in size on quality photo paper. Not regular printer paper.
- Multiple entries of the same photograph in different classes will not be permitted.
- Only one entry per class.
- All entry forms must be received by Saturday, August 26, 2017 at 1:00pm at the Salmon Arm fair office.
- All exhibits to be accepted at the arena on Wednesday September 6, 2017

 - a. One picture of a pet animal
 - b. A collection of 3 photographs that display a 4-H activity or project
2. Unit 2
 - a. Two photos comparing indoor flash; one photo with flash, one photo without.
 - b. A collection of 3 photographs. One good example of low camera angle, level angle, and high camera angle.
3. Unit 3
 - a. One example of each form of movement. Panning, suggesting movement, and freezing movement.
 - b. A 5 picture photo story from a field trip or activity.
4. Unit 4
 - a. Two examples of each type of portraiture: Individual, child, and group
 - b. Five close up pictures shot with a close up lens or using the macro feature on your camera.
