Regulations:

- One entry per class per member
- All rabbits must be from the member's current year project and must be properly tattooed and recorded on the entry form.
- No tattooing after rabbit arrives. All tattoos should be properly dried and all excess ink should have disappeared.
- Rabbits may only be shown in one breed type, mixed breeds will be shown separately in each class.
- All feed and water containers must be supplied by the 4-H member.
- Members must bring their own penning: recommended pen size rabbits weighing:
 - 6lbs - 15" x 16" cage
 - 6-12lbs -21" x 23"
 - over 12lbs - 30" x 27"
- Please indicate amount of table space you will require on the entry form.

1. Commercial Type Breeding Stock
 - a. Doe
 - b. Buck
2. Fancy Type Breeding Stock
 - a. Doe
 - b. Buck
3. Wool Type Breeding Stock
 - a. Doe
 - b. Buck
4. Doe with Litter – Doe must be from previous year's achievement. Doe to be shown with five to eight week old kit(s) on day of show.
5. Replacement Project
 - a. Doe
 - b. Buck

Showmanship: (Classes 6-8)

Members will be judged on method of handling and knowledge of their project animal and or breed

Method of Scoring – Total 100 points

- Showing of rabbit – 30 points
- Appearance and condition of rabbit – 25 points
- Appearance and attitude of club member – 25 points
- Actions of 4-H member – 10 points
- Knowledge of rabbit – 10 points

Class:

6. Junior Showman – Age 9-11 years
7. Intermediate Showman – Age 12-14 years
8. Senior Showman – Age 15 and over
Champion and Reserve Champion Showman (for classes 6-8)

Class:

9. Costume Class – Rabbits must be on a leash
10. Agility Class – Rabbits must be on a leash

Classes 9 and 10 to include Open contestants, both classes have to be entered, not just one. Open contestants only will not house animals at the Fair overnight for 2017 only.
