GENERAL RULES

- Registration forms are to be submitted to the Fair Office.
- Committee has the right to combine classes. Combined classes will be run concurrently but judged separately.
- ASTM Approved Helmets must be worn in all 4-H riding classes, English or Western. Cowboy hats may be worn for Showmanship only.
- Class descriptions can be found on the Salmon Arm Fair website.
- Western Horsemanship and English Equitation will have a Championship Round for Junior and Senior. The top two competitors from each unit will be allowed to move into the championship round.
- Showmanship Championship will be a combination of points earned in showmanship classes. Exhibitors must show in both classes to be eligible.
- Junior members are 9-12 as of January 1, 2017. Senior members are 13-19 as of January 1, 2017.
- Units will be followed as set out in the BC 4-H Horse Regulations. Members must ride in the unit they were put into at the beginning of the project year.
- Only registered 4-H projects may be shown.
- In classes broken down by Walk/Trot, Junior and Senior, only members in Units One and Two can enter the Walk/Trot Class.
- Members riding Senior horses (six years or older) must show one handed in a Western shank bit. Junior horses may be ridden two handed in a snaffle bit or bosal. Exception: Unit one and two may ride two handed in a snaffle, regardless of horse's age.
- For Speed events (barrels, pole bending and keyhole), all members are encouraged to use snaffle bits and will not be penalized. English or Western Tack may be used.
- Showmanship, English Equitation, Western Horsemanship and Trail classes will all have patterns posted at least one hour before start of show. It is a member's responsibility to know the pattern before entering the class. Equitation/Horsemanship Championship classes will be just rail work.
- Showmanship and Trail/Handy Horse may be shown in either English or Western Attire.

- Showmanship exhibitors are to show with a well fitted halter (leather or nylon) and lead. Chains are allowed but not required. If showing in English attire, exhibitors may show with a bridle.
- Trail classes will have a second judge and be open gate.
