- Please contact the convenor if you have questions about show rules.

Regulations for Dairy Goats

- Refer to Rules & Regulations at the front of this book for deadlines, times and procedures for entry, exhibit delivery and exhibit pick-up.
- All animals must pass a mandatory Health Check by the Veterinarian to be eligible to move into the pens and take part in the show.
- VET CHECK TIME: Thurs, 6:00pm - 7:30pm
- Animals with natural horns are not eligible to be shown.
- Over-distended udders will be heavily faulted.
- No milk to be sold on the fair grounds.
- The base date for computing age of an animal shall be Sep 7, 2018.
- Limit of 2 entries per exhibitor per class per breed.
- Pen space will be assigned in the order in which entries are received. ENTER EARLY!
- STALL CLEANING at the end of the fair is the responsibility of the exhibitor (we are a volunteer organization!). Cleaning of pens may be arranged by pre-payment of \$5.00 per pen by separate cheque with entry.
- Show colours for open Dairy Goat Show will be black bottoms and white tops.

60. Dam & Daughter
61. Breeder's Herd - Three does. One milking doe 2 years or older, one dry or milking yearling, one 2016 yearling. All must be from one breeder.
62. Get of Sire - Three does, any age, from one sire. One may be borrowed. Name sire on entry.
63. Progeny of Dam - Two does, any age, from one dam. Name dam on entry.

GOAT DIVISION AWARDS Presented Sunday Afternoon

- Golden Fork Award - Best kept pens and presentable animals. Judging during all three days of the Fair. Ribbons 1st – 3rd Trophy.
- Top Herdsman - The herdsman with the most aggregate points for animals and pens. Rosette.
- Top Breeder – The most aggregate points in one breed.
