- Exhibitors must submit a photocopy of HCBC membership
- Please ensure you have included the following with your entry:

 - 2) Proof of HCBC membership
 - 3) Stall Deposit (If required)

Stabling:

- Competitors wishing to stable on the grounds must supply a \$25.00 deposit to be paid via a SEPARATE cheque.
- Cheques will be destroyed once stalls have been cleaned.
- Stabling availability is on a first come, first service basis. However, preference will be given to out of town and 4-H exhibitors.

Parking:

- A parking pass is NOT required on trucks and trailer units for exhibitors hauling in each day to compete. However, if your truck and trailer is going to remain on the grounds after 9:30pm, a camping pass must be purchased. (\$30 for the weekend)
- Parking is not allowed in stabling areas.
- Classes with fewer than 3 entries will be combined whenever possible.
- Large classes will be split into sections with a ride-off to follow immediately. Split classes will be posted.
- Show Committee reserves the right to cancel classes whenever necessary.
- Classes will be run as close as possible to the Prize List, but the Management reserves the right to change any order or time schedule or modify any classes they deem necessary.
- **Competitor number packages and passes will be available starting Sunday @ 8:00am from the tent located at Blackburn gate. DO NOT GO TO FAIR OFFICE TO PICK UP THESE ITEMS.**
- Competition numbers must be worn and visible at all times in the schooling and exercise areas as well as in the competition ring.
- Free chasing or loose exercising of horses in rings is PROHIBITED.

Cancellation Policy:

All fees will be refunded prior to the closing date. After the closing date, if horses entered are not shown, a veterinarian/ medical certificate must be presented **BEFORE** the start of the competition day for refund of fees. The show will retain \$20.00 of the fees.

Scratch policy:

Every horse entered in the show must be shown **UNLESS EXCUSED FROM THE CLASS BY THE SHOW COMMITTEE**. Failure to comply may result in **ALL** prize money being forfeited. No refunds of fees will be given.

NSF CHEQUES

There will be a \$30.00 charge on all NSF cheques.

- 3) Western Equitation
- 4) Western Horsemanship
- 5) Western Pleasure
- 6) English Equitation
- 7) Road Hack
- 8) Show Hack
- 9) Hunter Under Saddle
- 10) Western Command Class or English Command Class

Walk/Trot, Stake & Jackpot placings will not be used. Points will be awarded to 10th place in each of the classes listed above. Horse/rider combo with the highest cumulative total will be considered the winner.
