

## A1 Division: Arts and Crafts Judging Standards and Guidelines

1. All articles in competition must be the work of the exhibitor and entered in the name of the exhibitor.
  2. All articles must be original in design and execution.
  3. All articles must be made within the last 24 months and not previously entered in the fair.
  4. One entry per class.
  5. Presentation must meet class standards, ie. framing, mounting.

### Judges considerations for painting, drawing, sculpture:

1. Quality of composition
2. Technical skill in use of media
3. Overall presentation and impact

### Judges considerations in collections, cards, collage

1. Quality of workmanship, with a clean, finished look
2. Original design (collage/stamping must be layered and re-created)
3. Overall presentation and impact

### Judges considerations for jewelry, beadwork, fibre art

1. Technical skill and use of appropriate media
2. Complexity of design
3. Overall presentation and impact

### Judges considerations for pottery

1. Technical skill evident in consistent walls and clean edges
2. Original design/shape/sculptural elements
3. Overall presentation and impact

### Judges considerations for woodwork

1. Technical skill evident in clean edges, sanding and finishing
2. Original design, sculptural elements and details
3. Overall presentation and impact
