3 day parking (Livestock exhibitors and Vendors only)

Note: Livestock/supply trailers are exempt from parking fees, but must park in designated areas. Parking on the grounds is restricted to vehicles and livestock/supply trailers belonging to livestock and commercial exhibitors. Passes can be purchased on the entry form or at Blackburn Gate. No parking will be permitted on the grounds except in designated areas, and all vehicles within these areas must display a valid parking pass. Failure to comply will result in being towed at owner's expense. **Zero tolerance! No warning will be issued and vehicle will be towed!** Livestock feed or concession supplies to be unloaded within the grounds before 9:00am only.

Three day Camping (livestock exhibitors and vendors only)

This will provide one three day Camping Pass and one three day parking pass. Camping on the South Grounds is restricted to RV's belonging to livestock and commercial exhibitors. No hook-ups are available. Each unit must purchase and display valid passes and are to have visible identification on the unit. Camping units will be assigned a designated numbered space on a first come, first serve basis. Please park as directed. Vehicles not complying with the direction of the Salmon Arm Fair parking staff or occupying an excess of space will be towed at the owner's expense. Passes can be purchased on the entry form or at Blackburn Gate.

2018 Rules & Regulations

ENTRY FORMS ARE AVAILABLE ON THE WEBSITE FOR PRINTING AT www.salmonarmfair.com. Online registration is available at www.salmonarmfair.com until midnight Aug 27, 2018. For online entries only a one time registration fee of \$2.00 is required in addition to all entry fees and must be paid at the time of registration.

1. Registration:

- a. Entry Forms and fees (NOT exhibits) must be received by Monday, August 27th. Mailing address is on entry forms. To enter in person, bring to the Memorial Arena (behind Centenoka Park Mall) at the Fair Office – 351 3rd St SW. Salmon Arm, BC, V1E 1V4. Online Registration is open until midnight Aug 27, 2018.

- b. Photography exhibits please read the new changes in the division rules and refer to 3 (f) below.
- c. With the exception of livestock and photography, only ONE ENTRY will be accepted in each class per exhibitor. Livestock may enter two entries per class per breed.
- d. Errors on the entry forms are the exhibitor's responsibility.
- e. Late entries will NOT be accepted.

2. Exhibitor Fees :

- a. Adult exhibitor is \$15.
- b. Youth exhibitor (6-18 years) is \$10, including **all 4-H**.
- c. Preschooler (5 and under) exhibitor is FREE.
- d. The Exhibitor Pass provides admission to the Fairgrounds for all three days of the Fair.
- e. Residential Care Facility: group entries will receive three one day Fair passes.

3. Delivery of Indoor Exhibits (Not Spinning):

- a. All indoor exhibitors will pick-up exhibit tickets from the front of Memorial Arena between **noon and 7:00pm, Wednesday, Sept 5, 2018** with appropriate tickets to locations below.
- b. Arts & Crafts (A1), Textiles & Needle Arts (A8), Flowering Wheelbarrows (B2), Fruit/Vegetables (B4/B5) and Scarecrows (C4) will take tickets and exhibits to the Memorial Arena.
- c. Baking/Canning (A2/A3), Lego (A11), Photography (A5) will take tickets and exhibits to the Dance Studio Building, directly behind Arena.
- d. Honey (A4), Farm & Field Crops (B1), Flowers (B3) and Preschool (C5) will take tickets and exhibits to the Artisan building.
- e. Spinning (A7) exhibits must be delivered to the Artisan Building on Thursday, September 6th, between 3pm and 6pm.

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4. Pick-up of Indoor Exhibits:

- a. **All exhibits must remain on site until 5:00pm Sunday.** Removal of exhibits before that time will result in forfeiture of prize money and may exclude exhibitor from future registration.
- b. All exhibits must be picked-up at 5pm on Sunday. If the exhibitor cannot pick up his/her exhibit, arrange for someone else to do so. The Fair will not be responsible for items left after 6pm on Sunday, and cannot be held liable for any loss.

5. Animal Exhibits:

- a. **All animals** must be on the grounds **by 9pm Thursday and must remain until 5pm Sunday.** Failure to follow these rules will result in the forfeiture of prize money and may exclude exhibitor from future registration.
- b. Exhibitors criticizing or interfering with the judges while in the ring or on the exhibition grounds will automatically have their entry disqualified.
- c. **Health Requirements:** All livestock to be free of infectious or contagious disease, ticks, lice, flies and keds. Animals not fit for show to be immediately removed from the fair grounds.
- d. Canadian Food Identification Agencies approved tags must be on all livestock before entering the fair grounds
- e. Stall cleaning at the end of the fair is the responsibility of the exhibitor. Failure to clean stalls will result in forfeiture of prize money.

6. Exhibit Liability: All exhibits on the premises are at the risk of the owners, in case of loss or damage of any extent or by any cause.

7. Prizes:

- a. Prizes for Division A, B and C ***will be paid in cash during the Fair. Exhibitors are asked to pickup their winnings in the Arena Foyer, 4-6pm Sunday.*** Prizes more than \$100 will be paid by cheque and mailed. Prizes for other divisions will be paid within thirty days. Please cash all cheques promptly.
- b. In all classes, it will be left to the judge's discretion to award prizes as he or she sees fit. In the event of there not being sufficient prize money to pay prizes in full, directors reserve the right to pay prizes on a pro rata basis.
- c. ***Stale-dated cheques or prize money not claimed will be considered a donation to the fair.***
- d. If any errors or omissions are made in prize awards, the fair office must be notified in writing within two weeks of the date of prize cheque.
- e. Any complaints must be made within three days. Protests must be made in writing, accompanied by a fee of \$20, which will be returned if the protest is sustained.

Dogs:

Only Guide dogs will be permitted on the fair grounds. 4-H Dogs will show Sunday at 9 am and then be removed from the fair

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grounds at the end of their show. Dogs may not be in any livestock area or barns.
